## Learning is fun

**!** 2B1 students had been working very hard on their Weather Reports for the countries in our Inspired network. Ms. Corpus assigned the location of one of our sister schools to the children. They were to research (using weather.com) the weather conditions of that location for Wednesday, March 14<sup>th</sup>. Using the correct keywords, they searched images of the place that represented the weather conditions for that day. Next, they used their critical thinking skills to decide what type of clothing would be appropriate for that day, adding this important information to their script. Once the scripts were written, with Ms. Cornelius' guidance the students filmed their segment in front of the green screen and each student edited their own segment using the Green Screen app by Do Ink. The final step was combining all the segments together to one final awesome weather report that covers all 33 Inspired schools over 12 countries and 5 continents! Awesome activity for extraordinary students and teachers!

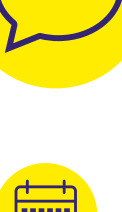

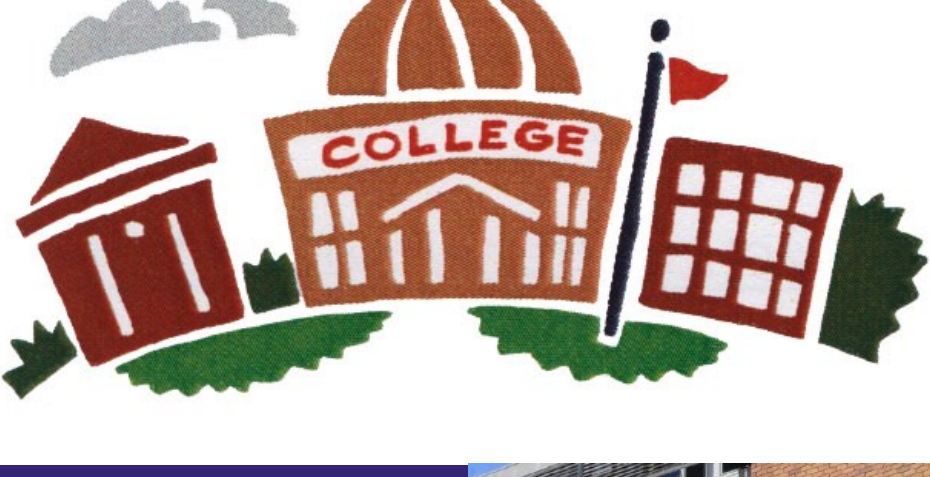
