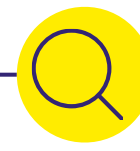
Starting Monday, February 5th

Parent Ambassadors & Communicators

At the end of 2018 we hope to have, selected by the parents, representatives of each class. The representatives, in turn, will elect the five delegates that conform the Ambassadors Board of Directors. As of this year, class representatives (previously called spokespersons) will be called BVS Communicators, working closely with our Communication Department. Based on the experience gained during these three years, the Communicators will be chosen as follows: In elementary, parents of A classes will choose their Communicator during the meeting at the beginning of the semester; the Communicator for B classes will remain the delegate from last year. In high school, current ambassadors will contact those who have been delegates previously or with parents in each class to design an election system. In August, A classes of FS18 will elect their representative and all democratically elected Communicators will choose the five members of the new Ambassadors Board of Directors. Members of the board will serve for two years (August 2018-2020).
