Research shows we learn 80% of what we do and students in Mr. Ronhaar's 8 B biology class were learning. To study "How do body systems work together to maintain health?" they used the respiratory system of a pig and the dissections of a shrew and a rat to solidify the understanding of the digestive, muscular, and skeletal systems. Supported by technology, using a document camera, the teacher



projected his dissecting on the white board for all the class to be able to observe it. Then, the students dissected chicken wings to look at how the skeletal and muscular system work together for movement.

OUR BUS ROUTES WITH TRAVAO

To improve efficiency in time and cost of the routes, this semester we started the process of centralizing bus service for our students with a company. Mrs. Vicky Molina, 2215 2204 ext 123, will continue to be our intermediary and our bus norms persist (Manual p. 84.) But for routine matters: information, contracts and payments, please go to the people named below. Our drivers, who have earned our trust through years of service to Blue Valley, founded Travao S.A., a company with digital systems to design routes that allow changes (even during the semester) necessary due to the needs of our population (frequent address changes). The first bimester served us well to polish details (e.g. a chauffeur charged for the month and broke the contract the 15th, taking the prepaid money with him). Payments are being standardized; they will no longer be between parents and driver, but through the company staff. Service needs to be paid by the fifth of the month for the bus to continue picking up the student. The driver may receive payment through a check made to the order of TRAVAO S.A., but transfers are preferable, with the same student's code for monthly payments.
